Fund Description

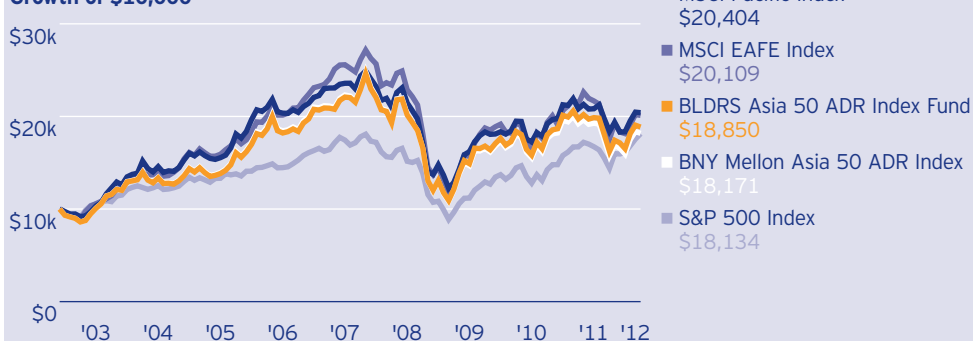
The BLDRS Asia 50 ADR Index Fund is based on the BNY Mellon Asia 50 ADR Index, which is a capitalization-weighted index designed to track the performance of approximately 50 Asian market-based depository receipts. The Fund normally holds at least 95% of its total assets in depository receipts that comprise the Index. The portfolio is rebalanced and reconstituted quarterly.

There are risks involved with investing in ETFs, including possible loss of money. 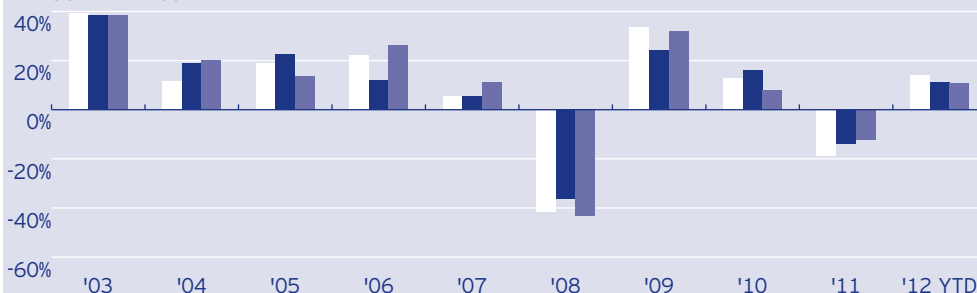

About risk

Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Earnings Ratio (P/E Ratio)

is the share price divided by earnings per share. It is measured on a 12-month trailing basis. **Weighted Harmonic Average Stock Price-to-Book-Value Ratio (P/B Ratio)** is the ratio of a stock's market price to a company's net asset value. **Weighted Harmonic Average** is a method of calculating an average value that lessens the impact of large outliers and increases the impact of small ones. **Weighted Average Return on Equity** is net income divided by net worth. **Weighted Market Capitalization** is the sum of each underlying securities' market value.
