Fund Description

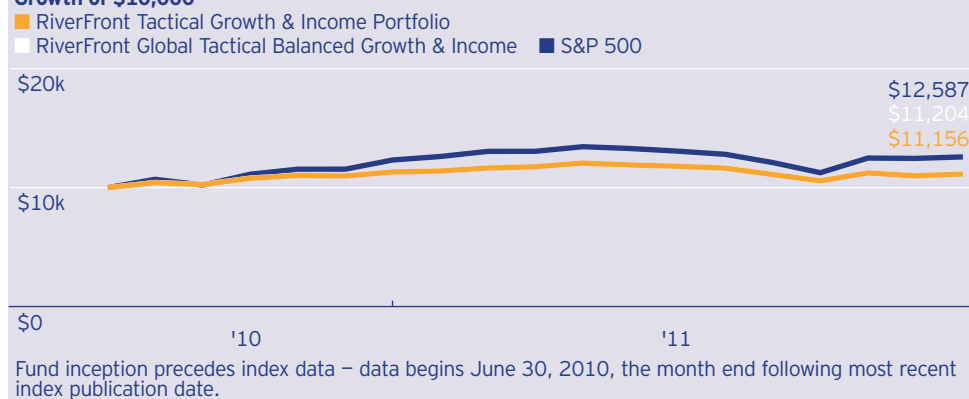
The PowerShares PowerShares RiverFront Tactical Growth & Income Portfolio is based on the RiverFront Global Tactical Balanced Growth & Income Index™.* The Fund will normally invest at least 90% of its total assets in the securities of funds included in the Index. The Fund is a "fund of funds," as it primarily invests its assets in the securities of funds included in the Underlying Index, but may also invest in exchange-traded notes ("ETNs") and equity and fixed-income securities included in the Underlying Index. The ETFs included in the Index and their appropriate weights are chosen through RiverFront's proprietary and patented Price Matters™ optimization process.

The Index is optimized relative to a growth risk profile targeting approximately 50% equities and 50% fixed-income securities. The underlying Index is generally adjusted quarterly, though monthly rebalancing may be necessary in volatile markets to ensure the 50/50 risk target is met.

There are risks involved with investing in ETFs, including possible loss of money. Shares are not actively managed and are subject to risks similar to those of stocks. Ordinary brokerage commissions apply. The Fund's return may not match the return of the Underlying Index.
